

Plants for Deep Shade that are great for Union County NC

Deep shade is considered less than 2 hours of sun per day. Each plant lists one of the common names and the botanical name. The notation spp. indicates there are multiple species available.

- Bugle Weed *Ajuga reptans*
- Barrenroot, *Epimedium x rubrum*, *Epimedium x versicolor*
- White Wood Aster, *Eurybia divaricata*
- Fern variety, *Dryopteris spp.*
- Hellebore, *Helleborus orientalis*
- Hosta 'Blue Mouse Ears', *Hosta 'Blue Mouse Ears'* **BE AWARE Deer will eat this like candy**
- Bigleaf Hydrangea, *Hydrangea macrophylla*
- American Holly, *Ilex opaca*
- Winterberry Holly, *Ilex verticillata*
- Anise tree, *Illicium floridanum*
- Hardy Anise Shrub, *Illicium parviflorum*
- Solomon's Seal, *Polygonatum odoratum*
- Rusty Blackhaw Viburnum, *Viburnum rufidulum*
